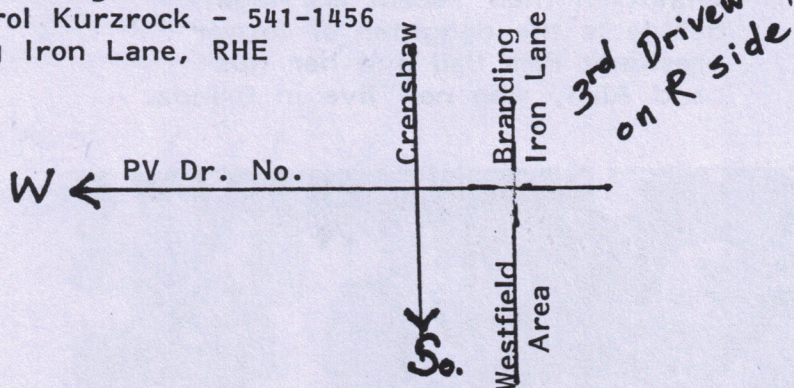

Our hearts go out to **TEDDY GREENWALD** on the passing of her beloved father, Victor Morosco.

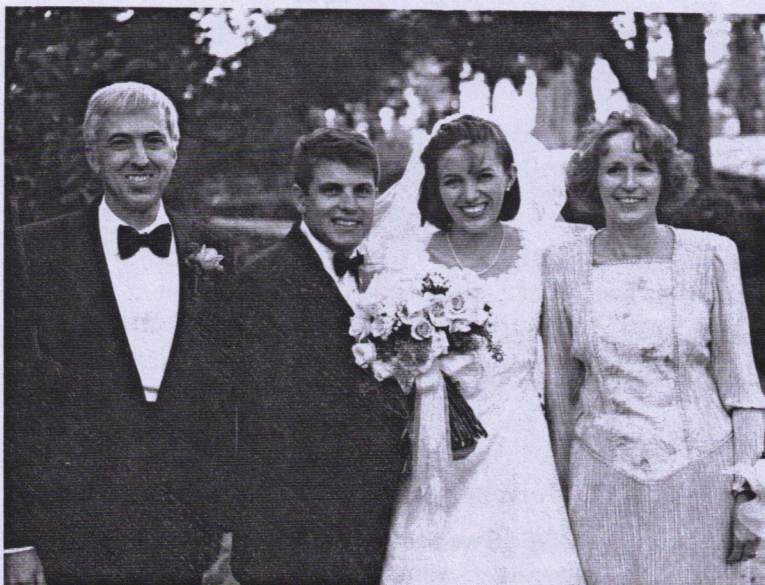


